Pest Management

Pest management presents a unique challenge in protecting health, at the same time providing health and environmental benefits. Because pests carry micro-organisms that can cause diseases, and thus could be a potential source of contamination, pest management is a non-negotiable aspect of operating any business that involves people.

A wide variety of pests can be located in the human environment with some pests more prevalent than others. Some of the more common pests are:

- Rats and mice;
- Fish moths (especially where paper is stored);
- Flies;
- Crickets;
- Fleas and
- Cockroaches



Rats and mice not only carry life threatening germs but are often guilty of chewing through cables which can result in the loss of valuable data.

Cockroaches have been reported to spread up to 33 kinds of bacteria. They spread diseases such as dysentery, gastroenteritis, typhoid and poliomyelitis.

There is, unfortunately, no quick-cure for pests and regular treatment is required to prevent proliferation, contamination and infestation.
